Re: Section 889 of the 2019 John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) and Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 52.204-25 (Prohibition on Contracting for Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment)

Dear Valued Supplier:

The U.S. Government has revised FAR 52.204-25, effective Aug 2020, to implement the restrictions in Section 889(a)(1)(B) of the 2019 NDAA. Generally, this rule prohibits federal agencies from contracting with entities that use telecommunications and surveillance equipment or services from the following companies and their subsidiaries or affiliates, including but not limited to:

**Huawei Technologies Company,
ZTE Corporation,
Hytera Communications Corporation,
Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, and
Dahua Technology Company**

All Intellisense Systems Suppliers should familiarize themselves with the requirements of FAR 52.204-25, as this restriction on delivery of covered products will be a requirement in many contracts. In the meantime, regardless of whether such a requirement appears in your contract, we are asking suppliers to proactively monitor their Supply Chains to ensure that the listed telecommunications or surveillance equipment or services from the above-referenced sources are not quoted or supplied to Intellisense Systems Inc.

Should any supplier become aware that products or services from the listed sources have been or are being provided to Intellisense Systems during contract performance, please contact your Authorized Intellisense Systems Procurement Representative identified on your Purchase Order and notify in writing for follow up and containment.
